The School of Data Science (SDS) <u>announced the approval of the new Ph.D.</u> program by the UNC System Board of Governors in June. Pending final accreditation by SACS, the degree is set to launch in fall 2025. This program will feature two pathways: one for future industry leaders and another for academic careers, focusing on machine learning, AI, and statistics, along with data ethics and social implications. The Ph.D. program expands on our Master's and Bachelor's degrees and reinforces our commitment to advancing data science education. SDS will also join the College of Computing and Informatics (CCI), boosting interdisciplinary research and faculty development. *Stay tuned for details on our October information sessions to learn more about this exciting new program!* Founded in 2020, SDS is the first School of Data Science in the Carolina's \$41.2 million investment in data science and engineering.
